OLD BUSINESS:

1. 2013 Budget

Manager DeLong stated that there have been no changes to the draft budget since the Special Meeting on November 8th, 2012. If the Board of Supervisors have no additional changes, Manager DeLong feels that the Budget is ready to be adopted and advertised to the public for review and comment.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS:

Manager DeLong discussed the situation on Buckeye Road, within the Township. He states that Buckeye Road is a state road under the jurisdiction of the state. The Township does not have much say in what is going on. The Township is however hoping that the road can be open as quickly as possible because of the businesses affected in that area. Manager DeLong stated that the contractor has been removing all of the contaminated soil within the area. Essentially, they are digging where there was fuel oil and then testing the soil. They are essentially chasing contaminated soil. The areas being tested are both the north and south side of Buckeye Road, for a distance of about 280 feet to the East of Tank Farm Road and on the East side for about 400 feet. All of the wells in that area have been tested and the home owners will be notified of the results. Manager DeLong is confident that the wells have not been contaminated. Manager DeLong stated that the Township has been more than cooperative to help this situation move as smoothly as possible. Supervisor Sentner stated that the environmental situation is bad enough but there are also

businesses in that area that are being affected by this. Supervisor DeVault was concerned about whether or not the residents in the area could get in and out of their homes. Manager DeLong confirmed that everyone has been very accommodating to the residents being affected. Supervisor Sentner asked if there is anything that the Township can do, at this point. Manager DeLong explained that there is nothing more that the Township can do; however, everyone involved is doing everything possible. They are definitely working to get the problem taken care of as quickly and efficiently as possible. Manager DeLong stated that it is a major problem.
