PUBLIC INPUT: Robert Schmeltzle Jr. speaking as a resident. Robert expressed his concern that he was almost rear ended twice waiting at the light as he sat on Shimerville Rd waiting to get out to Chestnut St since the traffic was backed up to the sharp turn.

Phil Casey noted that years ago there was a red motion light at a driveway years ago near that area to alert drivers of motion from the driveway. Is there a way to get that working again?

Supervisor Mohr relay a story about being passed by a truck on the left on the double yellow line around the turn near there as well.

George Reed asked if the Township could post a driveway sign and speed limit sign near 7301 Corning Road down the hill. The traffic is going to fast and he and his wife have almost been in accidents at their driveway.

Supervisor DeVault asked what the posted speed limit there is. There is no speed limit so the speed defaults to 55mph.

Supervisor Sentner recommended that Brian Miller put out the traffic counter to gather data for that stretch of road.

Manager DeLong mentioned that the driveway signs are on the homeowner to purchase. The Township will install. Mr. Reed just needs to contact the Township Office.

Fran Caputo stated that he felt the only way to control the speed is to have state police enforce the speed limits in areas that are a concern.

James Krippe asked what the proposed \$25.00 per person tax gives us extra for State Police coverage.
