 - a. Letter from Treasurer Emily Fair
 - b. Approval of Payment from General Fund PLGIT XXX7096 check # 17921 in the amount of \$49,765.52 and Acknowledgement of transfer # 2018-071 from Citizen's Fire Company Capital Reserve PLGIT XXX7067.

Vera Cruz Fire Company requested \$49,765.52 from their Major Fire Fighting Fund to pay off the second Loan on unit # 2812. This will allow them to save the higher interest rate over the remaining length of the loan and to free up \$11,480.00 each year from their operating budget.
