- 1.) Approval of Bid Recommendations

Township staff prepared and advertised to receive bids at 1:00 P.M. on March 25, 2019. Bids were received and opened by Township Manager, Bud Carter and witnessed by Cindy Kuhns. Bids were received for:

- 1. Bituminous Seal Coat
- 2. Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course
- 3. Line Painting

Bid tabulation results are attached.

Based on staff's review of the bids I recommend that the Board of Supervisors award the bids and enter into contracts with the lowest qualified bidder in each category as follows:

#### 1. Bituminous Seal Coat

Award to: **Asphalt Maintenance Solutions,** LLC P.O. Box 387 Center Valley, PA 18034, For the contract amount of \$178,200 with final determination of the application to be determined during field operations.

# 2. Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course

Award to: **Asphalt Maintenance Solutions**, LLC P.O. Box 387 Center Valley, PA 18034 For the amount of \$82,156.15.

# 3. Line Painting

Award to: **A-1 Traffic Control** 430 Hallman Road Douglassville, PA 19518 For the amount of \$16,426.08 in 2019 and \$16,605.60 in 2020.

Supervisor Sentner asked if there was something that could be done about the line painting since the paint doesn't last very long. Manager Carter said that the alternative is very costly and gets scrapped off during the winter plowing events.
