<u>Fire Companies</u>: Supervisor Sentner stated that the Fire companies had lots of calls from the storm from water rescues to basement pump outs and vehicle accidents. He was happy to let everyone know that they had no injuries or equipment losses throughout the Storm.

<u>Emmaus Library:</u> re-opened to the public on July 6<sup>th</sup>. Staff and patrons are happy to be back. Everyone is wearing masks and there are distancing measures in place. The Library asks patrons to limit their stay to an hour to allow everyone access to the Library. Summer reading has 33 participants (149 children, 58 teens and 127 adults). There have been 26 new resident Library cards issued since re-opening. On 08/15 from 3-4 on the front lawn there will be a butterfly release and on 8/20 there are craft pack available for custom wands.

<u>Daniel Mohr</u> – Supervisor Mohr is glad the rain is over. His neighbor had 7.75 inches in the rain gauge. He commented that the storm wasn't reflected very well on 69 News.

<u>Robert Sentner</u> – <u>Supervisor Sentner made a Motion</u> to send a letter to PennDOT requesting a proper repair and not an emergency repair to the area of Rt. 29 across from the Trivet. <u>Supervisor Moore seconded the motion</u>. Hearing no other questions or comment, all were in favor, motion carried. He was also glad everyone made it through the storm.

<u>Joyce Moore</u> – Supervisor Moore urged patience and is grateful everyone is OK. There will be storms tonight and with an already high water table be prepared in case of additional flooding.

#### Township Manager:

<u>Bud Carter –</u> Manager Carter wanted to thank Public Works for all of their efforts. The Township recorded 6.73 inches of rain which closed roads and saw flooding and trees down. They worked cleaning and repairing roads. He also thanked the staff in their efforts with taking and documenting all of the phone calls and concerns.
