## **ORDINANCE NO. 171**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF UPPER MILFORD TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE USE AND ENJOYMENT BY THE PUBLIC OF THE UPPER MILFORD MUNICIPAL CENTER PROPERTY; PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE BY THE PUBLIC THEREIN; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS OF THOSE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Upper Milford Township ("Township") is a Second Class Township located in Lehigh County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors ("Board") may by ordinance regulate the use and enjoyment by the public of any grounds and facilities owned and maintained by the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township owns certain property known as the Upper Milford Municipal Center Property located at 5671 Chestnut St., Zionsville, Pennsylvania ("Property"), and the Board is desirous of adopting rules and regulations for the use and enjoyment by the public upon the Property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Milford Township, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of Upper Milford Township hereby adopt the attached rules and regulations for the Property for the use and enjoyment by the public. A copy of the rules and regulations are attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked as Exhibit "A".
- 2. The rules and regulations shall be posted in conspicuous places on the Property.
- 3. Any person who violates the rules and regulations shall be guilty of a summary offense, be sentenced to a term of imprisonment which shall be fixed by the Court at not more than ninety (90) days, and/or be fined in an amount not to exceed

One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per violation. In addition, any person found guilty of a summary offense shall be directed to make restitution to the Township, be responsible for all reasonable attorney's fees and expenses incurred by the Township as a result of the prosecution and be responsible for all costs of prosecution.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this
 Ordinance are hereby repealed.

5. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.

## **EXHIBIT "A"**

## UPPER MILFORD TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL CENTER PROPERTY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Automobiles may be driven and parked only in driving areas specifically designated for parking, and at no time shall motor vehicles of any description be permitted on the lawn or seeded areas without the express permission of the Board of Supervisors. No vehicle maintenance shall be conducted on the premises.
- 2. No littering or dumping shall be allowed and refuse shall be placed in the proper receptacles for recyclables and non-recyclables. Refuse is that which is generated in the park; no disposal of household refuse.
- No outdoor fires for cooking purposes or otherwise.
- 4. No person shall be allowed to cut, mutilate, remove, take or carry away any trees, shrubs, flowers, or plants of any nature whatsoever unless it be with the specific permission of the Board of Supervisors. No excavation by hand, tools, or equipment is permitted.
- 5. No mineral deposit of any nature whatsoever, including, but not limited to Jasper, shall be removed from the property(s).
- 6. Consumption of alcohol is prohibited. Use of indecent, profane, and improper language is not tolerated. Disorderly conduct of any type will lead to prosecution.
- 7. Pets are permitted on the Property; however, the same shall be the absolute responsibility of its owner, and all dogs shall be required to be on a leash and under proper and adequate control, including the proper removal of pets' feces.
- 8. The removing, defacing or destructing of any sign, poster, fixture, building or any other property on the premises is expressly prohibited.
- 9. The use of firearms, archery, air rifles, or any device capable of discharging a projectile is strictly prohibited and no hunting, trapping, or taking of wildlife is permitted in park areas unless specifically carried out by an officer of the law or other authorized person performing his assigned or authorized duty.
- 10. No political or religious demonstrations or rallies shall be allowed or placards, advertisement, public notices or personal cards shall be distributed, posted or affixed in any manner other than notices from the Board of Supervisors.
- 11. All bicycle or other wheeled activity shall be conducted only on designated areas. Helmets and proper safety equipment are required. No motorized vehicles, unlicensed recreational vehicles, snowmobiles or the like, are permitted. (Not including vehicles and equipment associated with agricultural practices or other such motorized equipment as may be necessary for property maintenance.
- 12. The Property is a drug free area.
- 13. Recreation area users shall be permitted on the premises between dawn and dusk prevailing time only.
