NOTICE is hereby given by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Milford Township that it is their intention to consider and act upon a proposed revision to its official Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan ("Plan") at a public meeting to be held on August 30th, 2005, at 7:30 p.m. in the Upper Milford Township Municipal Building located at 5831 King's Highway South, Old Zionsville, Pennsylvania, 18068. Thereafter, the Township will submit the plan to the PA Department of Environmental Protection, Water Management Program, 2 Public Square, Wilkes-Barre, PA 18711-0790 as required by the Act 537. The purpose of the Plan is to review the existing sewage needs of the Township and to propose extending sewage service to those areas, where required, to address failing on-site treatment systems.

The Plan revision considered a number of sewage facilities alternatives including providing sewer service to the Leibert's Creek Basin through the Borough of Emmaus using a gravity interceptor, providing sewer service to Leibert's Creek Basin through the Borough of Emmaus using pumping stations, providing sewer service to Leibert's Creek Basin through Lehigh County Authority Route 29 facilities using a pumping station and a gravity interceptor, providing sewer service to Leibert's Creek Basin through Lehigh County Authority Route 29 facilities using a pumping station, providing sewer service to Leibert's Creek Basin through Lehigh County Authority Route 29 facilities using a Low Pressure System, providing sewer service to the Leibert's Creek Basin through a new wastewater treatment plant with stream discharge to Leibert's Creek Basin, providing sewer service to Leibert's Creek Basin through a new wastewater treatment plant with land application discharge, extending sewer service to the South Fifth Street area, extending sewer service to the South Seventh Street extension area, extending sewer service to the Indian Creek Drainage Basin, extending sewer service to the Hosensack Creek Drainage Basin, extending sewer service to the Swabia Creek Drainage Basin, extending sewer service to the Golf Circle area, formation of a sewage management district and no action at all.

W., All Marlon Pl., 4031-4391 Mill Rd., 4371-3501 Quarry Dr., 4102-4287 Shilerville Rd., All Sickle Circle, All Sickle Rd., All Spruce Rd., 4521-5501 Vera Cruz Rd. - The Township should proceed with construction of collector sewers to service portions of the Leibert's Creek drainage basin as outlined in Alternative # 4.

Estimated Project Costs: \$7,245,060

Funding: The project will be funded by a combination of grant(s), municipal contributions, property assessments, capacity tapping fees and institutional financing. A conservative interest rate of 5-percent per annum has been assumed for the project costs that will be financed to reduce the property owner's up-front costs for the public facilities. However, as the project progresses, the best available financing, such as Penn Vest will be pursued. Various types of additional funding are being sought to reduce the overall financial impact on the property owners and include Lehigh County Community Block Grants (CDBG), US Dept. of Agriculture Grants and Loans and other Federal and/or state funding sources that are available.

Up Front Fees for Public Facilities: All properties within the Project Area will contribute to the project by paying, when applicable, the following estimated fees.

Benefit Property Assessment: Reflects the amount of benefit that the property is estimated to receive because of the availability of public sewer. The amount of the assessment varies, ranging from a low of approximately \$40.00 to a high of \$18,000.00, with an average of \$1,110.00. All properties within the project area, except those exempted by law will pay an assessment.

Capacity Tapping Fees: Purchases capacity in both the project area facilities and the non-project area facilities that convey and treat the wastewater. The fees are purchased on a Per-Equivalent Dwelling Unit (Edu) basis and are: Wastewater Treatment, \$884.00; Western Lehigh Interceptor, \$603.00; Little Lehigh Relief Interceptor, \$119.00; and Project, \$1,644.00, for a total of \$3,250.00 per-Edu. As an example a single-family residence will pay \$3,250.00, a three-unit apartment building will pay \$9,750.00 and a single-family residence with an apartment will pay \$6,500.00. All properties required to connect to the sewer system will pay these fees.

User Charges: It is estimated that properties within the Vera Cruz Project Area that connect to the sewer system will pay an annual user charge of \$1,378 per Edu. The charge will be composed of two parts, the then current Upper Milford Common Rate charge, currently \$451.00 plus a Vera Cruz Project charge estimated to be \$927.00.

Mandatory Connection Requirement: In accordance with the §67502(a) of the Second Class Township Code all properties that are adjoining or adjacent to or whose principal building is within one hundred and fifty feet (150') from the sanitary sewer will be required to connect.

Remaining Areas of the Township: The remaining areas of the Township within the Proposed Sewer Service Areas will be serviced on an as needed basis. Based on the results of the needs survey, there is no immediate requirement for the installation of sewers in any other area of the Township at this time.

Septic Management Program - The Township will, within nine months following the plan approval, initiate the development of a Septic Management Program for all properties not connected to the public sewer facilities. This program will be enabled through the adoption of a Septic Management Ordinance and require that all on-site systems are periodically maintained and inspected.

Other Agency's Consistency Requirement:

The Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission has stated that significant archaeological resources may be within the project area and any currently undisturbed areas that would be disturbed by the project would need additional studies to comply with PHMC requirements.





This program will be enabled through the adoption of a Septic Management Ordinance and require that all on-site systems are periodically maintained and inspected.

Other Agency's Consistency Requirement:
The Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission has stated that significant archaeological resources may be within the project area and any currently undisturbed areas that would be disturbed by the project would need additional studies to comply with PHMC requirements.
