

Upper Milford Township Open Space

The Supervisors and Staff of Upper Milford Township would like to thank the residents and Landowners for their support of the Open Space Referendum. In 2016 the Upper Milford Township Open Space Referendum was on the Ballot in November. The referendum passed with 59.25% of the votes in favor. That means there were 2,547 out of 4,299 votes in support of the Referendum. Since January of 2017, the Open Space Tax Revenue has gone into a separate fund. This separate fund has been instrumental in preserving 236.10 acres of farm and woodlands. Since the Referendum was in the beginning stages in 2016, Upper Milford Township preserved over 323 acres of land and contributed \$584,000 to Open Space Preservation.

Upper Milford Township has approximately 1022 Acres in Agricultural and Conservation Easements within our borders. With our Open Space initiative, along with State and County preservation money there is hope that more can be accomplished. The next deadline for preservation applications is July 1st, 2020.

Residents are Encouraged to Use the Township's Yard Waste Site

- Upper Milford Township encourages the composting of leaves and yard waste. For more information about composting, please contact the Township.
- Yard Waste Drop Off Site Information:
- The Township accepts yard wastes dropped off by residents at the Township's Yard Waste Drop Off area behind the Township's Garage, accessed via Church View Road. Materials may only be dropped off by Township residents and this service is not offered to lawn maintenance or landscape businesses.
- Grass, leaves, and brush or branches must be kept separated and unloaded at the appropriate location as identified by the signage at the site.
- Branches are limited to 4" diameter and must be no longer than 8'.
- Hours of operations are Wednesday from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Sunday 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Fall Hours not including Holidays beginning October 14th through December 13th are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 8:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m., Wednesday 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. or dusk, and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and Sunday 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Call the office at (610) 966 3223 for additional information.
- The Township, at times, has a supply of coarse wood mulch available to the public. Residents may load their own vehicles or the Township may load your truck or trailer by appointment only for a fee of \$5.00 per scoop or part thereof. The Township will also deliver mulch at a cost of \$40.00 per truck load which is approximately 7 cubic yards. You must prepay at the Township for the mulch to be either loaded onto your vehicle or delivered to your residence. Appointment hours are based on employee availability. Upper Milford Township Residents Upper Milford Twp. Yard Waste Collection Program

Upper Milford Township is offering residents a fee-based roadside yard waste collection program as a supplement to the Township's Yard Waste Drop-Off site program.

The collection dates will be scheduled for May 11th – 15th, 2020 and again for November 9th – 13th, 2020.

Residents desiring to use the roadside pick up service will be required to purchase a yard waste pick up sticker for each container or bundle to be picked up at a cost of \$1.00 each and also comply with the following procedures:

ONLY the following materials or items will be accepted and collected:

• Dirt

- Leaves
- Tree and Plant Trimmings

• Tree Limbs and Branches, less than 4 feet long and 4 inches in diameter

• Garden and flower bed plant materials

The following items WILL NOT be accepted and if placed out for pick-up will result in material not being collected:

Grass Clippings

• Garbage

- ngs Animal Waste • Lumber
- Sod
- Rocks

Tree Stumps

Trash

Acceptable materials must be placed in open containers no larger than 32 gallons in size and have a total weight of less than 50 pounds. Limbs and branches less than 48" long and 4" in diameter may be tied in bundles no larger than 48" x 18" x 18" (maximum weight 50 pounds). Ties must be biodegradable material.

A new "yard waste sticker" must be fastened to each container or bundle or the material will not be collected. The sticker on the container will be removed or voided after one use.

Residents must contact the Township Office by either calling at (610) 966 – 3223, faxing (610) 966 – 5184 or e-mail info@uppermilford.net to schedule pick-up. Notification must be received by the Township prior to 12:00 noon on Friday of the collection week or material may not get collected.

Stickers may be purchased at the Upper Milford Township Office, 5671 Chestnut Street, at a cost of \$1.00 each. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. The Stickers may be prepaid and they can be mailed to the resident.

The Township is required to offer this program or service in order for the Township to comply with current Pennsylvania Recycling Regulations.

Planning on Digging?

Call Pennsylvania One Call System, Inc. (POCS) three business days before you dig at 800-242-1776 or 8-1-1.

PA Act 287 as amended requires excavators as well as private landowners to call POCS three days prior to any type of digging occurring with powered equipment.

Mark your excavation area in white paint before calling with a dig notification.

By calling you allow the facility owners the opportunity to locate and mark their underground facility in advance of the planned excavation (gas and liquid pipelines will mark underground facilities using yellow stakes, flags or paint.)

Exception Real Estate Tax Bills:

- A "Change in Assessment" (due to a new house, improvements such as a garage, pool, or home addition, lot-line adjustments, etc.) may result in an Exception Bill, an additional pro-rated bill covering the difference between the old assessed value and the new assessed value. These bills are mailed in February, May, August and September and cover the period from the "effective date" until the new taxable rate is reflected on your tax bill. Exception Bills will have a different discount, face and penalty period than the original tax bill.
- Exception bills received throughout the year usually are not paid by the mortgage company. Property owners are encouraged to contact their mortgage company to determine if they will pay any supplemental bills.

- Failure to receive a bill does not entitle the owner to discount or remission of penalty on taxes.
- If you no longer own the property, please provide name of new owner on bill and return to tax collector's office.
- If serviced by a Mortgage Company, it is the property owner's responsibility to forward township bills and school bills to them immediately.
- Township tax payments & school tax payments cannot be combined. Separate checks are required.
- On-Line /Electronic checks are accepted.
- Credit cards are not accepted.
- Partial payments are not accepted exact amount required.

Permits Required

Upper Milford Township is a zoned community. The following are required:

- **Bonfire Permit:** required at least 10 days in advance of the proposed bonfire.
- **Building and/or Zoning Permit**: required for new construction, additions, or alterations of existing structures; deck, patio, pool, spa or hot tub; electrical work or wiring; plumbing and HVAC work; and shed.
- Driveway Permit: required for a driveway or other means of ingress or egress onto a State/Township road.
- Fence or Wall Permit: required for the installation of any fence or wall over two feet high.
- Grading Permit: required if not in conjunction with another permit.
- Moving Permit: required when moving into, out of or within Upper Milford Township. (NO FEE)

- Occupancy Permit: required prior to occupying a newly constructed building.
- Park Permit: required in order to reserve a pavilion in a township park.
- **Peddler's Permit:** must be obtained before engaging in solicitation or peddling in Upper Milford Township.
- Sewage Permit: required for a new septic system and repair or enlargement of an existing system.
- Tree cutting and Logging Permit: required if more than 10 trees/ year or more than 30 percent of total number of trees on lot are taken down. Call the Township office for specific information.
- Use or Change of Use: required for any activity, occupation, business, or operation carried on or intended to be carried on in a structure or lot.

Other permits may be required for certain activities. For specific information call 610-966-3223.

Do you know the benefits to becoming a subscriber to the Emmaus Ambulance Corps?

If you are subscriber...Your insurance company payment will be accepted as full payment (provided your deductible has been met). If your insurance company doesn't pay anything towards the bill or you do not have any insurance, you will receive a 50% discount on the charges for emergency services.

Subscribers also receive discounted rates for non-emergency medical transports.

If you are not a subscriber... You will be responsible for 100% of the amount charged for the service. If you don't have insurance or any balance is still due after your insurance company payment has been received, you are still responsible to pay any outstanding debit. It can cost hundreds of dollars for a single emergency, as emergency rates can reach as high as \$900.

If you haven't received a subscription notice by mail in October, please pick one up at the Emmaus Ambulance Corps Office, Upper Milford Township Building, or Emmaus Borough Hall. A full explanation of your benefits is provided in the subscription mailing.

Payments for services or your subscription should now be made at the Borough Hall. Payments can be made by mailing back your subscription, stopping in or calling the Borough at 610-965-9292 to pay by credit card.

Even if a subscription is not right for you, The Emmaus Ambulance Corps welcomes your tax-deductible donation. The Emmaus Ambulance Corps relies on subscription memberships, donations, grants, insurance reimbursements and user fees to sustain and improve its advanced life-saving operations and to purchase state of the art lifesaving equipment and supplies to help provide the necessary services of the operation. Like in many medical emergencies, time is of the essence for a





wildlife habitat

Remove these invasive species:



Shrub that spreads quickly and crowds out native plants

Presence of Lyme disease carrying ticks is increased in areas where barberry is prevalent



Bradford Pear Fast growing tree that out competes natives for light and nutrients Branch structure makes it susceptible to breakage and splitting

Day Lily



Quickly spreads from yards into natural areas where it forms dense patches that displace native plants Thick tubers make control and removal difficult



Plant these natives species instead:

Common Ninebark

Fast growing shrub that is drought tolerant, disease and insect resistant

- Attracts bees and birds
- Produces white flowers in early summer

Eastern Redbud

- Deer resistant tree that does well in shady locations
- Attracts bees and birds
- Produces fragrant pink flowers in early spring

Butterfly Milkweed

- Deer and drought resistant perennial Attracts butterflies and
- hummingbirds. Larval host for monarchs
- Produces long lasting, showy, orange flowers throughout the summer

The Hivel Und Dahl Preservation Society has been in existence in Upper Milford Township since 1992. The current goal of the organization is to successfully restore the Schubert-Graber Log Cabin in Powder Valley. This is generally considered to be one of the oldest existing structures in the township. Built in the late 1700's by a Schwenkfelder cooper named Melchoir Schubert, this stone and log bank building has corner posts with mortise and tenon joinery.



The building has been placed on the National Register of Historic Places as the Schubert-Graber Log Post Shop. Hivel Und Dahl is now ready to begin restoration of the building. We haveengaged G. Kevin Stanley as contractor for the job. The restoration will be done in phases, and phase

1 includes dismantling the existing structure and inventorying the logs to see what can be reused, and covering logs and stone foundation to protect from the weather. The cost of phase 1 is \$29,000.

After restoration is complete, it is hoped that the site will serve as a repository for Pennsylvania German memorabilia and can also be made available for school tours, architectural studies, and events for the community.

We are in the process of a Capital Campaign to raise funds for this project. You may have received information about this in the mail. In addition to contributions from members and township residents, we are applying for grants from several foundations.

Please consider supporting us by contributing to this project and/or becoming a member of Hivel Und Dahl Preservation Society. Single membership is \$20. Family membership is \$25,/annually. We meet quarterly - March, June, September, and November. Our meetings are at 7:00 in the township building on the last Tuesday of the month.
