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Monthly Report for June 2023 Upper Milford Township

Call Volume

The Macungie Ambulance Corps responded to 423 calls for service this month.

27 of those calls were in Upper Milford Township.

While we were busy on other calls, our mutual aid partners responded to 5 calls for assistance in the Township this month.

Other Points of Interest

Every day our members respond to calls for assistance, care for people, and help them in their time of need. In fact, on average, we respond to over 12 emergency calls per day. While every call is unique and important, during the month of June, two stand out.

In the middle of June, a resident of our coverage area was saved from Cardiac Arrest with bystander CPR, EMS care, and coordinated treatment from a local health network. Victims of Cardiac Arrest survive only 10 -15 % of the time.

Later in the month, our organization was dispatched for a fall victim at a local residence. The caller was not on-scene and stated his mother had fallen and could not get up. Upon arrival, our crews found the patient confused on the floor near the front door. A faint odor was noted and a crewmember's personal CO meter began activating.

They removed the female patient, searched the rest of the home, and found her husband unconscious in a second floor bedroom. They quickly removed him as well. The fire company was notified and found extremely high levels of carbon monoxide in the home. Several ambulances and members from our organization responded and provided care. The patients were initially transported to a local hospital and then transferred, one via helicopter, in critical condition to a hospital in Philadelphia for hyperbaric oxygen treatment. Both patients survived and made a full recovery.

They recently stopped by with their family to meet the members that helped save their lives.

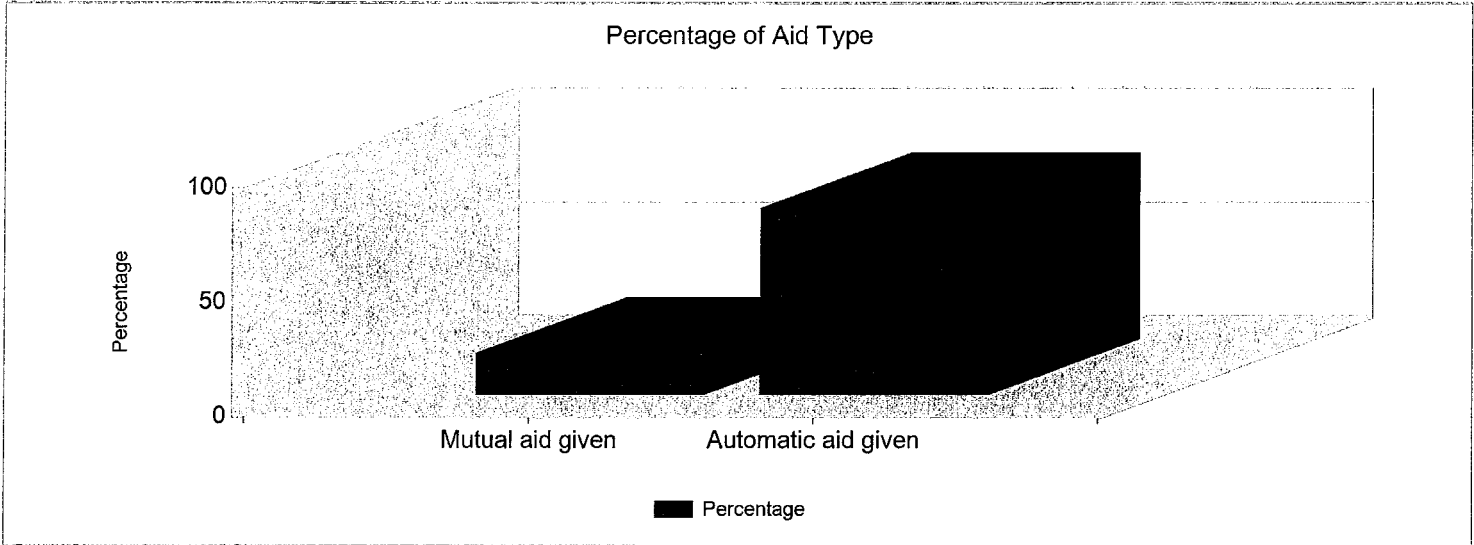

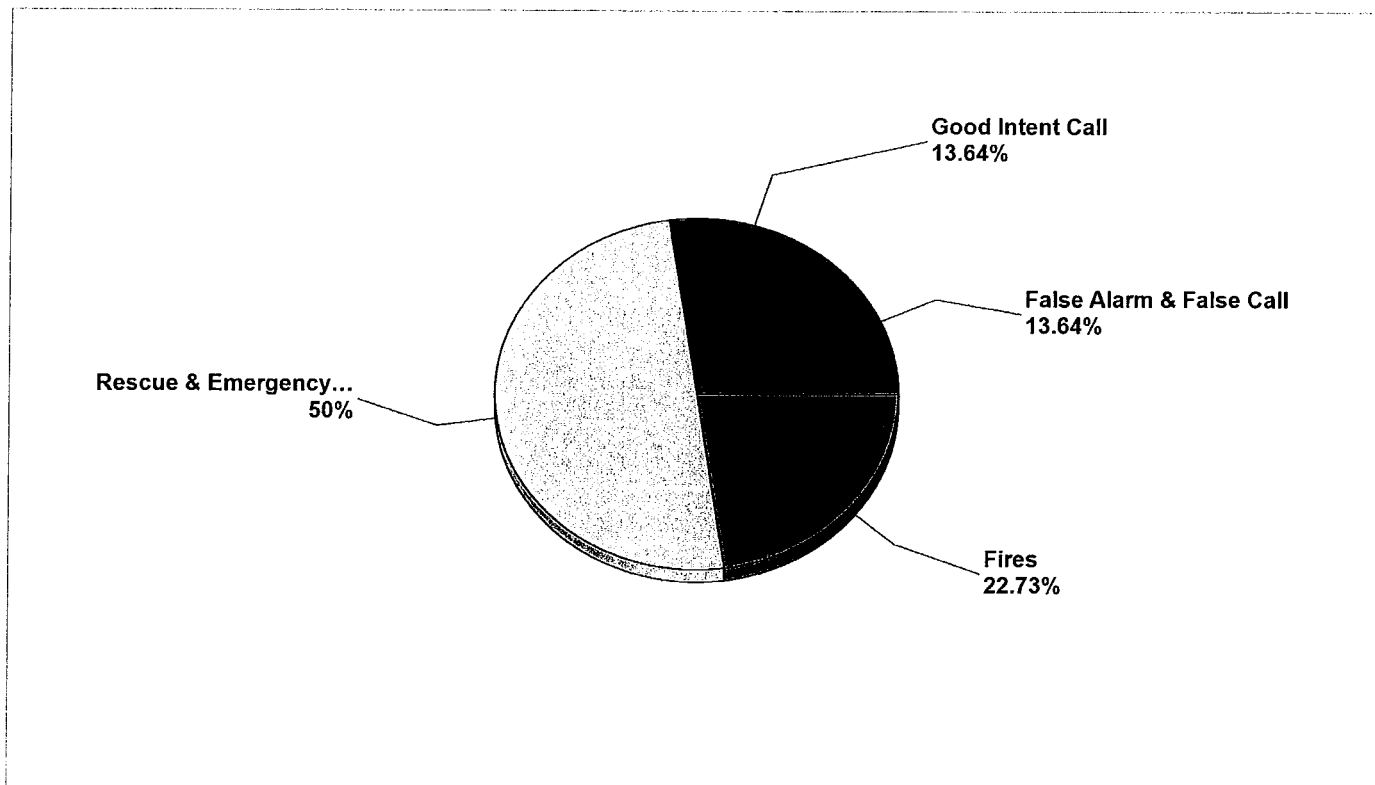
